## The CANDE Utility command

Sort of like the Run or Execute command

- > But has much more capabilities
- > And is easier to use

#### **Instead of Run command**

Saves entering the (" and ")

- > RUN \*SYSTEM/DUMPALL ("INTER")
- > U \*SYSTEM/DUMPALL INTER
- > U \*SYSTEM/PDIR XX= {SO- LASTA}
- > R \*SYSTEM/PDIR ("XX={SO-LASTA}")
- > You can still file equate as normal U MYPROG MYPARAM; FILE CARD = MYDATA; TASKSTRING = "ABC"

## The utility part of the Utility command

You can use and/or alter your current workfile

- > When the utility program is run CANDE sets a number of attributes and file equations for you
- > It also sets various bits in the TASKVALUE
- > Caution: "U" removes extraneous spaces (i.e. leading, trailing & duplicate spaces) "R" does not.
  - So R PROG ("A G") is not equal to U PROG A G

# File equations

The following files are file-equated

- > WORKFILE Name of work file(if any)
- > WORKSOURCE Saved or unsaved work source
- > NEWWORKSOURCE Potential new unsaved work source
- > WORKOBJECT Saved or unsaved work object(if it has been compiled)
- > NEWWORKOBJECT Potential new unsaved work object

## What is it good for?

- > Running Utility programs E.g. EDITOR
- > Starting compile WFLs
- > Editing files with an external program
- > Etc.

### **Example programs**

- > Here are some simple utilities that I wrote over 20 years ago
  - G Gets a source and sets MARKID to <your initials>/MMDDYY.

If initials not entered then first 2 letters of your USERCODE. Also sets the status bar text.

- E.g. "U G MYFILE DD"
- C Saves the source and starts 'WFL/COMPILE/COBOL85 ("<myprog>","OBJECT/<myprog>")'

## **Samples**

- > Here are some samples from Paul Kimpel
  - UCASE -- up-cases the text in the workfile.
  - UNSTAR -- removes the COBOL comment "\*" from column 7 for otherwise blank lines in the workfile.
  - LISTER -- a glorified CANDE WRITE utility. This will paginate
    either the work file or a named file after the "U". It's currently
    wired to Paul's laser printer with a particular PAGECOMP, but
    that's easy to replace either in the source or through file equation.
