## Collection of OS 2200 Utilities and Libraries

- ▶ <http://cgibin.rcn.com/leistlc>
- ▶ Provides access to more than 30 utilities and libraries
- ▶ Items are in PKZIPed FTPack format
- ▶ Recognize TDATE\$ or MODSWTIME timestamps
  - ▶ New elements will generate timestamps in the site's current format
- ▶ Documentation and examples included on website for subset of utilities
  - ▶ Also README files available after installation

## Examples of OS 2200 Tools

- ▶ BK1/BK2
  - ▶ Quick way to breakpoint to and from print files with options to open with editors
  - ▶ Example that lists all elements in a file, puts in BK\$ (username) and opens BK\$ in @ED
    - @bk1
    - @prt,t filename
    - @bk2,e
- ▶ FLIST (originally from University of Maryland and enhanced by Les Leist)
  - ▶ Lists contents of a tape and other files
  - ▶ Tape listing includes filenames and element names
- ▶ FSED (original author is John Cambell and enhanced by Les Leist)
  - ▶ Full screen editor
  - ▶ Has been enhanced to support screens up to 80 x 132

## Examples of OS 2200 Tools

- ▶ TOCED
  - ▶ Table of Contents Editor modeled after @ED text editor
  - ▶ Able to list all elements in a file included deleted elements
  - ▶ Delete/undelete elements
- ▶ ZIP
  - ▶ Fast, read-only text processor
  - ▶ Read SDF files and elements
  - ▶ Useful to read large files such as PRINT files
  - ▶ Recognizes System Log and TPM trail formats
